

Lawmakers targeted for tax increases

Even if the state budget gets resolved, lawmakers won't be able to sit easy, at least one group of Clarkston residents will not let them. They want to repeal two key parts to the state budget -- the increase in the income tax and the expansion of the sales tax to some services.
